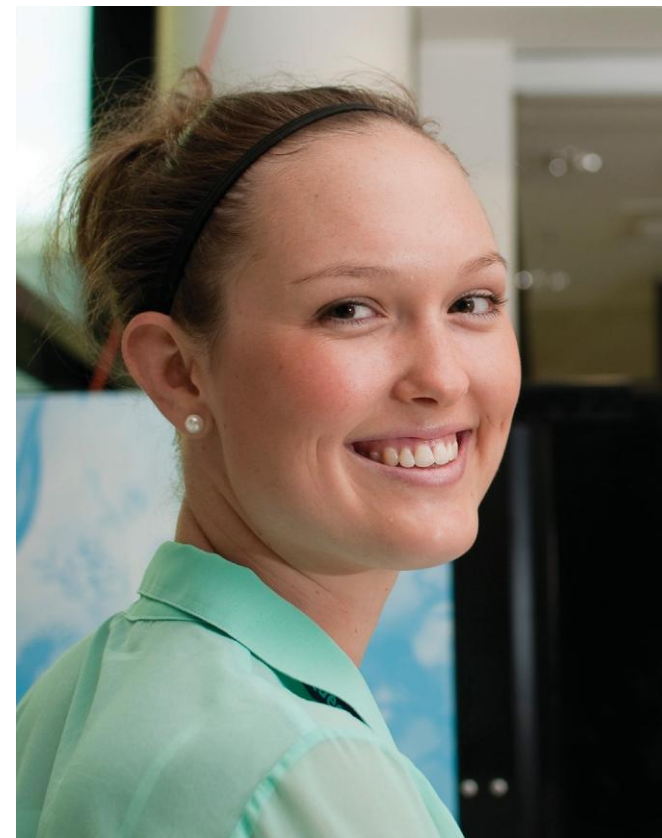

Hospital Consultation & Liaison

Hospital Consultation Liaison provides screening, assessment, intervention and specialist advice on drug and alcohol issues for inpatients of the Gold Coast University Hospital and Robina Hospital.

Assessment & Referral

A comprehensive clinical assessment collects information to define problems, understand how those problems are related to each other and make decisions on how to proceed with treatment and refer appropriately.

Counselling & Support

Counselling and support uses a wide variety of evidence-based techniques and therapeutic approaches that are tailored to meet the specific needs and circumstances of the individual.

Opioid Replacement Therapy

Opioid replacement therapy (ORT) is a medical treatment that involves replacing an illegal opioid, such as heroin, or illegal use of prescription opioids, with a longer acting but less euphoric opioid; Methadone or Buprenorphine (Subutex/Suboxone) are typically used and the drug is taken under medical supervision.

Community Programs

Information and interventions can be provided in the community to increase understanding of drug-related harm, treatment options and available services. Activities include dual diagnosis education, training and agency liaison.

Group Programs

Back in Control

A six session education program for people who have or have had a drug and/or alcohol related problem. Participants can request a Certificate on completion.

ADAPT

A dual diagnosis specific ACT based therapy program made up of eleven 2 hour sessions facilitated by specialist trained professionals. Participants can self-refer and require an assessment.

The DARE Program

The DARE (Drug, Alcohol Recovery Education) Program is a weekly 2 hour group session that promotes health and well-being in a positive, supportive environment. The program is abstinence based and enables substance recovery through solution focused education and peer support.

SCRAP Book

A six session self conducted, home-based education program for Gold Coast residents who have or have had a drug/alcohol concern for. A Statement of Completion can be provided.

Health Directory – Phone App

The smart phone app provides a comprehensive directory of all available alcohol and other drugs, as well as mental health services in the Gold Coast District. It can be installed on your phone by scanning the QR code.
